COMPARE THE CROWNS

The ceremony held at Westminster Abbey on Saturday May 6th 2023 merits some investigation.

It seems that the crown, placed that day upon the head of the man whom we know as charles philip arthur george windsor may not have been the regular one.

Here are some photos of postage stamps, (enlarged from two birth certificates, one dated 1939 and the second dated 1942) alongside a photo of a 2022 regular postage stamp showing our late Queen Elizabeth (*of happy memory*), daughter of the said King George VI.



(It was usual at that time for the '**REGIS**trar to sign across a postage stamp when making out a CERTIFIED COPY of an ENTRY OF BIRTH).

Now compare these photos with the design shown on the two plush chairs which appear in the background at just 18 seconds into the attached video clip taken at the 'coronation' ceremony.
